

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- Or, any school in the top 10% schools in each of the previous three years based on the detailed criteria in Section 2.C of Oklahoma's approved ESEA Flexibility Request
- Or, any school in the top 10% of state schools in improvement of mathematics and reading achievement between the prior year and three years prior based on the detailed criteria in Section 2.C of Oklahoma's approved ESEA Flexibility Request, unless the school is currently implementing a School Improvement Grant (SIG) or is a C3 Partnership School, according to "ESEA Definitions," http://ok.gov/sde/sites/ok.gov.sde/files/ESEA-Definitions.pdf

Four schools contracting with Alpha Plus last year were removed from the ESEA low-performing schools list. Two "Focus" schools in 2012 became "Reward" schools in 2013:

Bennington Elementary School and Byng Elementary School. A "Targeted Intervention"

(Peavine Elementary District) and a "Priority" school (Prue High School) improved math and reading test scores enough to be removed from the ESEA list of low-performing schools.
